3. Nominations Committee – elections in May; contact David if interested in a leadership role; Becky Evans announced she was moving from a Primary to Advisory Board role
4. Engagement with DeKalb Co. – Cynthia reported that it will be years before the Village can get funds for improvements from the County SPLOST funding for our streetscape improvements; she will check to see if the Village improvements can be lumped into funds for the N. Decatur Road mini roundabout project.

5. Village Maintenance - Todd to get proposal and cost for a 3-D model from his company for Village. Also, EVA needs to find a new company for fountain maintenance; will need cost estimate.
6. Open Streets 2019 – Date set for Sunday, October 27. Don Walker to initiate a planning meeting in April.
7. EVA Vision Session Discussion (session held in January 2019). Discussion around critical actions for the next 3-5 years (as identified at the Vision Session) and committees for implementation. The Board discussed this for most of the meeting (see separate grid of action items and individuals).
