### 2. Guest Introductions

### 3. Village Overlay

- Plans are being made for a community meeting to discuss the proposed changes to the overlay. The working group is working with DHCA to schedule this.
- Once all feedback is received and reviewed, the group will follow-up with the county Office of Sustainability to continue to move the process forward.

### 4. Olmsted 200

- The alcohol permit request is in process.
- Music talent for the concert on 4/30 has been secured:
  - John Wilingham opener
  - Shawn Mullins main act (until 9pm)
  - o DJ 9-10pm
- Site has been secured- will use grassy area across from Savey Provisions.
- Sarah will provide assistance/materials needed for promotion
- Volunteers will be needed to help with trash can, table set up and clean up.
- Fundraising continues to go well

### 5. Village Clean-up Workday

• A motion was passed to have a (pre-concert) clean-up day in the Village on Saturday, April 23, 8:30-11:30

### 6. Village Maintenance Issues

- Presentation and discussion with CEO Thurmond and COO Zach Williams went well. This included a presentation on Emory Village and the improvements that have been made as well as a request for more county investment.
  - The county sent a number of follow-up questions which have been responded to.

- A new recirculation pump has been installed in the fountain.

### 7. Signs in the Village

- DHCA has offered \$200 to put towards signs to dicourage theft in the Village but there is concern about the number of signs already present.
- Action Item:
  - A coordinated plan for placement of signs is needed to present to the property ownners. Todd, Marlene will meet with property owners to discuss the sign clutter
  - Anne W will follow-up with Doug Rollins at DHCA about the pending request for the placement of additional signs to discourage theft.

### 8. Roundabouts on N. Decatur

### 9. LCI Proposal

- The former Lucky's has been rented for an Indian "quick service" restaurant.
- Savi Provisions has received the necessary permits. Construction will begin soon.

### 11. Village Playground

- In follow-up to the discussion at the March meeting about establishing a playground space in the Village, it was clarified that:
  - Insurance for the playground in the Linear Parks is paid by the city of Atlanta
  - Given its location and the agreement regarding its purpose, adding playground equipment to Burbanck Park does not appear to be an option.
  - Further research will be needed to explore possible options for the playground
